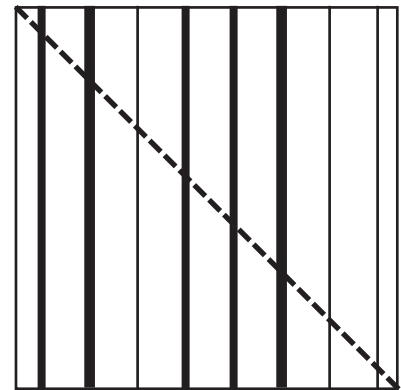
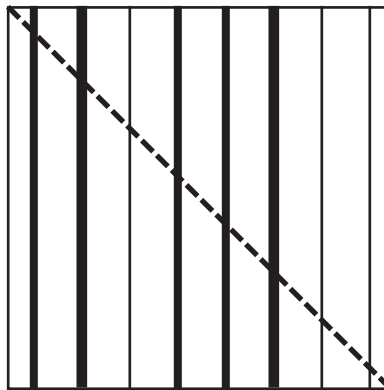
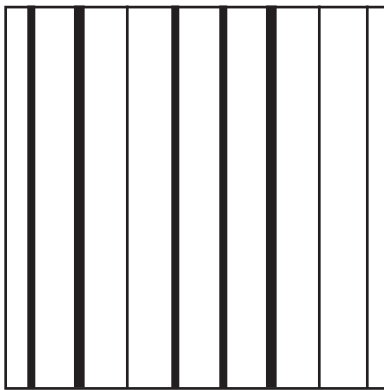
Hints for using directional prints with the *No Diamonds/No "Y" Seams* patterns

Place the squares of fabric right side down with the print going up and down. Draw the diagonal line from the upper left to the lower right. Every square of fabric with a directional print must have a line drawn on it in this manner. When placing the squares right sides together to sew, be sure the directional print is on top. If two directional prints are placed right sides together check front and back to be sure the lines on both squares are matched up. See the examples below.

Square placed right side down with the print going from the top to the bottom.

Draw the diagonal line from the upper left to the lower right on the wrong side of the fabric.

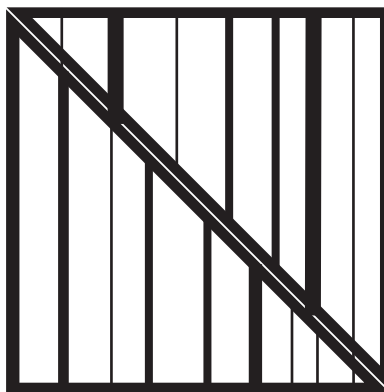
If two directional prints are placed right sides together, check front and back to be sure the lines on both squares are matched up.



These suggestions will help make directional prints flow in the same direction *most of the time*. The elements of the prints will not match up perfectly.

If this will bother you, don't use directional prints.
